

## **CURRICULUM PROF. ROBERTO BERNABEI**

Roberto Bernabei è nato a Firenze il 24 Gennaio 1952 e si è laureato nel 1976 in Medicina e Chirurgia alla Cattolica di Roma dove si è specializzato in Medicina Interna e in Malattie dell' Apparato Cardiovascolare.

E' professore ordinario di Medicina Interna alla Cattolica e direttore del Dipartimento Scienze dell' Invecchiamento, Neuroscienze, Testa-Collo ed Ortopedia del Policlinico A. Gemelli.

Dal 1998 al 2010 è visiting associate professor presso il dipartimento di Community Health di Brown University School of Medicine a Providence, RI.

Dal 2006 è Direttore della Scuola di Specializzazione in Geriatria della Cattolica.

Board member dell' European Academy for Medicine of Ageing negli anni 2001-2014.

Responsabile scientifico di numerosi progetti di ricerca ex art. 12 del Ministero della Salute, CCM ed AIFA.

Membro del Consiglio Superiore di Sanità negli anni 2002-2005, 2006-2009, 2009-2012, 2013-2014.

Vice-presidente prima sezione del Consiglio Superiore di Sanità 2010-2013.

Presidente della Società Italiana di Gerontologia e Geriatria nel triennio 2006-2009.

Membro del Consiglio di Indirizzo e Verifica dell' INRCA dal 2009 al 2012 e Presidente dello stesso dal 2018.

Vice presidente esecutivo negli anni 1992-2011 di interRAI, una non-profit corporation formata da oltre 100 ricercatori di 35 paesi esperti nell' assistenza continuativa all' anziano fragile e nella produzione di strumenti per la loro assistenza nei diversi servizi della rete.

## **ROBERTO BERNABEI**

Roberto Bernabei was born in Florence on January 24, 1952. He received his MD degree at the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart of Rome (UCSC, Rome, Italy) in 1976. He completed the Residency Programs in Cardiology (1979) and Internal Medicine (1984) at UCSC. He is Full Professor of Internal Medicine at UCSC and Chair of the Department of Aging, Neurosciences, Head-Neck and Orthopedics at the teaching hospital A. Gemelli of Rome.

He was appointed as Visiting Associate Professor at the Community Health Department at Brown University School of Medicine in Providence, RI from 1998 to 2010.

From 2006, He has been the Director of the Geriatric Residency Program of UCSC.

He was Board member of the European Academy for Medicine of Aging from 2001 to 2014.

He served as the scientific coordinator of several research projects ex art. 12 of the Ministry of Health, CCM and AIFA.

He was Member of the Italian National Health Council (Consiglio Superiore di Sanità) in 2002-2005, 2006-2009, 2009-2012, 2013-2014.

He was the Vice-President of the First Section of the Italian National Health Council from 2010 to 2013.

He was President of the Italian Society of Gerontology and Geriatrics (SIGG) from 2006 to 2009 and Member of the Scientific Board of INRCA, the Italian National Institute of Aging, from 2009 to 2012.

Beginning February 2018 he is President of INRCA.

From 1992 to 2011, he served as the Executive Vice President of interRAI, a non-profit US collaborative network of more than 100 researchers and MDs in over 35 countries committed to improving care for persons who are disabled or medically complex and specialized in the development of tools for the care of frail elderly persons across different healthcare settings.

He served as the Project leader of FP5 and FP7 projects of the European Union focused on the definition of the best care models for frail elderly persons, both at hospital and at home.

Since 2011 he has been appointed as the President of Italia Longeva Network, an organisation built on the partnership between the Italian Ministry of Health, Marche Region and INRCA, to promote the research on active aging and longevity.

He was Member of the International Advisory Board on Aging for Sanofi-Aventis in 2010-2011.

He was Member of the International Advisory Board on Alzheimer's Disease for MSD in 2016-2018.

He is the Leader of the Managing Entity of the Innovative Medicines Initiative (IMI) project SPRINTT (Sarcopenia and Physical frailty IN older people: multi-component Treatment strategies) (2015-2020).

His main research interests are in comprehensive geriatric assessment, health services for elderly care, sarcopenia, frailty, multimorbidity and geriatric pharmacoepidemiology.

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He published over 350 publications, 8 books, 20 book chapters.
